- Assessment is made by a panel of independent assessors. The assessment process includes an interview.
- You will be informed by letter whether your application for Full Membership (Overseas) has been approved.

Educational documentation. Must include copies of any relevant degree or other qualifications gained, and/or copies of

One garden/landscape design plan. If newly qualified, this could be a final design project. The plan may be for a residential or commercial project and will need to show general layout and circulation patterns, the use of hard landscaping materials and structured planting, including trees, shrubs, perennials and ground cover.
A completed and signed copy of pages 3-5 of this application form.
Your application fee payment.

Application documentation, including the required garden/landscape design plan, should be scanned and submitted in PDF or JPG format. **Email to:** <u>info@glda.ie</u>. Please ensure you keep a copy of the application for your records.

You also have the **option** to submit a hard copy of all your application documentation. It must be in a standard 2-ring binder or plastic folder. In this case, please include two plan copies folded to A4 in plastic sleeve (reduce the plan size if necessary). **Post to:** GLDA, 65 Roebuck Castle, Clonskeagh, Dublin 14, Ireland.
